Learning model

- ▶ Hybrid- 2 days in person/ 3 days remote

Remote- 5 days at home through zoom

Regardless of the mode of learning, expectations from students will be the same as regular school days

- ▶ Classwork will be assigned everyday however graded 2X week minimum.
- ▶ HW will be expected to be turned in everyday
- ▶ Exams will be conducted based upon teacher discretion
- ▶ Gradelink- Create Parents account- this will be the new system we use to record grades and post all assignments due dates. Register here: <https://secure.gradelink.com/2553/enrollment> (school code: 2553)
- ▶ Teachers will post all assignments on Google classroom
- ▶ Zoom will be used by all teachers to teach courses. Students must sign in according to bell schedule
- ▶ Attendance is required- Students must sign in remotely/in person
- ▶ Teachers will update Gradelink with students grades once a week (minimum 2 classwork grades will be posted and HW will be graded as assigned by the teacher). Please do not email the child's teacher everyday regarding their progress.
- ▶ If you see your child is missing 3 assignments on Gradelink and 2 weeks have passed contact your child's teacher immediately.
- ▶ 6X a year students will receive report cards

Covid 19 How does it spread?

- ▶ The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person. Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
- ▶ Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks.
These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.
- ▶ Some recent studies have suggested that COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

How can we prevent- Make sure your children

- ▶ Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- ▶ Use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol whenever you are touching surfaces or are outside. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- ▶ Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. Avoid close contact
- ▶ Limit contact with others as much as possible.
- ▶ Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- ▶ Remember that some people without symptoms may be able to spread virus.
- ▶ ***Make sure to send with your child hand sanitizer, snacks and bottled water. No sharing of food allowed***

Safety is our Priority

- All staff members and students are required to wear a mask or face covering.
- Social Distancing/All desks 6 feet apart.
- Temperature checks will be conducted before entrance into the building.
- No parents are allowed inside the school building without a mask.
- Cleaning and sanitizing of all material will take place consistently throughout the day.
- Hand Washing and sanitizing will be enforced throughout the day.
- Classrooms will be cleaned at the end of every school day.
- Encourage your children to take a shower every day. Once they come back from school make sure they change their clothes, wash their hands, etc.

Safety measures

- *If your child is even slightly sick (cough runny nose) they must stay home. If they have fever they cannot return to school unless cleared by doctor.*
- *If a child comes to school sick we will have to isolate them and send them home immediately.*
- *If any student or teacher in a single classroom is diagnosed with the virus we will close down school for two days until all investigation is carried out and students will only be asked to return to in person learning when administration is sure it is safe.*
- *If we have more than 2 cases diagnosed in school chances are we will have to close school until further notice.*

If a Teacher is Absent

- ▶ If a teacher is absent, your child will be provided instruction remotely. Do not send your child to school if the teacher is absent.
- ▶ Please make sure to check your emails and Gradelink notifications on a regular basis.
- ▶ Regarding a teacher's absence you will receive notification the night of or before 7AM that morning. Therefore we need for you to stay on alert.

Classwork will be posted before class

- ▶ The teacher will provide the assignment for each class by 8 AM everyday
- ▶ The assignment the teacher posts on Google classroom will be completed during class time and should not be completed before or after class.
- ▶ The student should only work on the assignment at the time of the class. The teacher will guide students during class.
- ▶ *****However if there are technical issues and the student is not able to login to zoom then the student should work on the assignment during the class time allotted in the schedule and send the assignment to the teacher. ***There should be no excuses not to submit assignments. The assignment should be sent at the end of the period (please check bell schedule)***

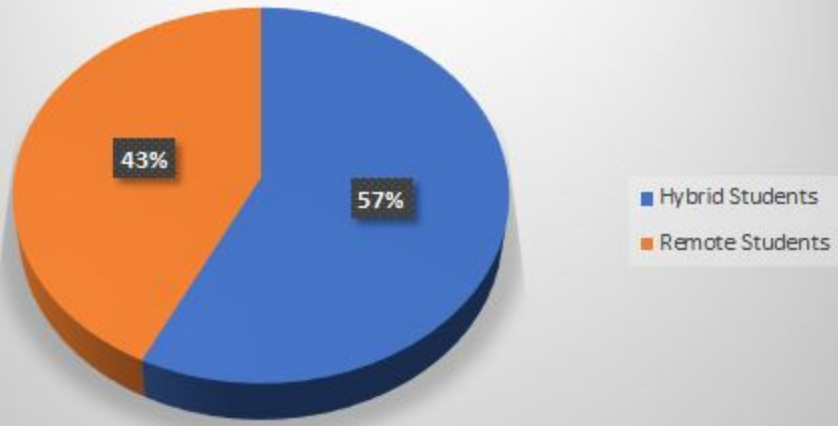
School Day Times

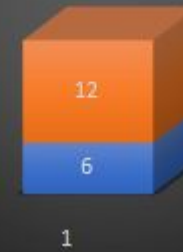

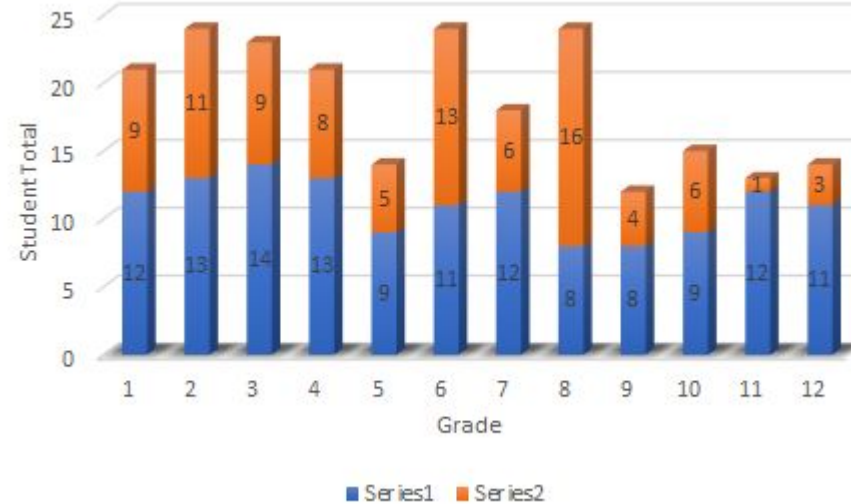
